2019 HILL & VALLEY EDEN VALLEY RIESLING

Our Hill & Valley wines showcase the great diversity of the regions surrounding the winery. From the cooler hill and elevated valley vineyards to those situated on the valley floor, these ancient soils provide the base for great wines that speak of their origins.

Vineyards	A blend of two of the finest Eden Valley Riesling vineyards, the grapes were sourced from Ben Zander's Wroxtton Block and Kevin Roesler's vineyard. Both sites are regular contenders for the highly coveted Wigan Riesling.		
Vintage Conditions	Low rainfall throughout the growing season, several frost events at budburst and a windy flowering period saw smaller crops throughout the Eden Valley. The end of summer returned to warm, steady daytime conditions combined with cooler nights which allowed even ripening, great acid retention and intense flavour development.		
Winemaking & Maturation	The grapes were picked in the cool of the night and cold settled overnight before racking and cold fermentation in stainless steel tanks. Following a two week fermentation period, the wine was clarified and bottled immediately.		
Colour	Pale green appearance.		
Aroma	Lifted citrus florals and hint of mandarin.		
Palate	Flavour is long and pure, with lovely lemon pith and the hallmark Eden Valley minerality to finish.		
Winemaker's Note	The Hill & Valley Riesling is a classic example of a Peter Lehmann white wine, with traditional Eden Valley qualities that make this region so renowned.		
Peak Drinking	It can be enjoyed fresh in its youth or can be aged with confidence to develop the mature bottle complexity expected of a top flight Riesling from this famed sub-region.		
Enjoy With	Enjoy lightly chilled - it is the perfect aperitif and the ideal wine with freshly shucked oysters, shellfish or delicate pan-fried white fish
